

# Trysting Tree Players Club 2019



Greetings from the TTPC!! We'd like to share some info about our program and planned golf activities for this year. We are an "Equal Opportunity" Club for both men and women at all skill levels.

**Fees:** This year's fees are \$70 which provides

- 1) membership to the OGA which includes a valid USGA handicap updated twice a month
- 2) opportunities to play in our weekly and monthly net and gross games and
- 3) potential to earn Tree Cup points credited toward Pro Shop and Restaurant purchases.

**Weekly Games:** Organized tee times on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday evening, Friday and Sunday for group competitions, both gross and net (for a small buy-in). These events are ongoing but the official start of these competitions (when you can start earning Tree Cup points) commences after the first monthly tournament (Beat the Pro) and continue thru the summer.

**Monthly Tournaments:** Scheduled individual and team events organized by the club to offer gross and net competitions and opportunities to earn additional Tree Cup Points. There is a fee for entry which sometimes includes a meal after the round.

- Sat. 3/23..Beat the Pro- a good warm-up competition to start off the season
- Sat. 4/20..Corvallis and Crescent Valley HS's benefit fundraiser
- Sat. 4/27..2-Person Scramble
- May 1..Kick off the full season bracketed match play tournament
- Sat. 5/18..2-Person Best Ball
- Sat. 6/15..Mid-Season Championship
- Thurs. 7/4..Sean's (the club pro) 4th of July 4-person team tourney (Scramble, Shamble, Best Ball)
- Sat. 7/20..2-Person Chapman
- Sat. 8/10..4-Person "On the Spot" Tournament
- Sat/Sun 9/7-8..2 Day Club Championship
- Sat/Sun 9/21-22..OGA 4-Person Team Championship (hosted at Trysting this year)
- Sat/Sun 10/5-6..Applegate Trail Cup  
Head to Head Competition with the Diamond Woods Club

**Tree Cup Points:** Tree Cup Points are allocated for participation in the weekly and monthly events. Two points are given for every Friday or Sunday (not both), one point for every Thursday evening game, and six points for every monthly tournament one plays in. Additional points are awarded to those players who win money (pro shop credit) in the tournaments. At The end of the season, the top 12 Tree Cup Point winners will earn additional credit in the pro shop. To compete in the year end club championship, a player would have to earn at least 15 Tree Cup points.

Come out and join the friendly (yet somewhat competitive) play and have some fun!!
